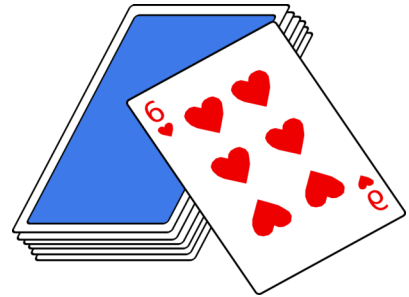
### Unpredictable Weather
