In Our Curriculum

Spelling— We will enter list 27 into our spelling journals with the test on Friday. The test will include a written narration of rule 16.

<u>Math</u>— We are learning about Lines and Shapes. The test for this chapter is scheduled for May the 15th.

<u>Writing</u>— We are completing a writing assignment about Colorado history that will display our writing skills. This piece will be pass on to our 5th grade teaches.

Reading— We continue reading <u>Fever 1793</u> by Laurie Halse Anderson in literature. This is a historical fiction about the yellow fever epidemic in 1793. We continue with <u>Little Britches</u> by Ralph Moody as our read aloud book.

History– Students are learning about our constitution and how it came to be. Ask your child to tell you about the three branches of the government.

Science— We continue with an experiment using the scientific method.

Grammar – In our <u>Fix It! Grammar</u>, we are identifying the parts of speech in the Nose Tree story as we copy it in our notebooks.

Poetry Monthly Recitation— Our May recitation is Portia's "Quality of Mercy" speech; an excerpt from *The Merchants of Venice* by William Shakespeare. Students will be given a copy of the speech.



Our Glen Eyrie tour is this week and next. Mrs. Rogers' and Mrs. Brunk's classes are going Thursday the 16th, and Mrs. Schell and Mrs. Kelley's classes will go Tuesday the 21st.
