

Capture! (Fences)

Multiplication

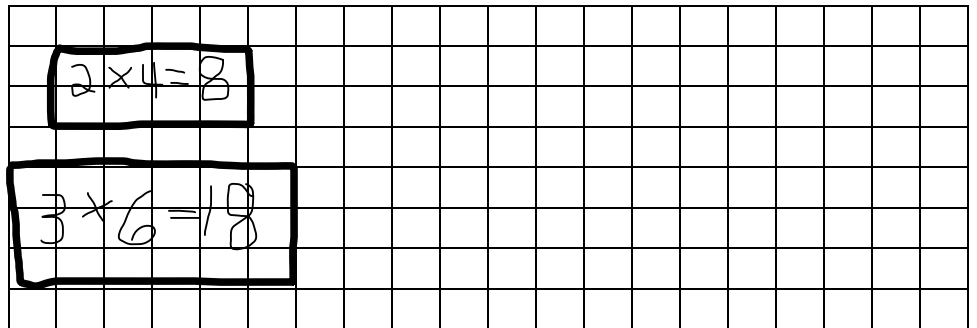
Materials:

- Graph paper (almost any size will work or you can print graph paper from the TCA website >parents/students > elementary parent resources > printable resources http://tcatitans.org/parents_students/elementary_parent_resources)
- Die modified with sides of: 2, 2, 3, 3, 4, 4
- A second die modified with sides of: 2, 3, 4, 5, 6, 7
- 2 different colored pencils or markers

Directions:

- Play with two players.
- Player One rolls the two dice and makes one the number of groups and the other the amount in each groups. They enclose that many squares on the graph paper and writes the multiplication problem in the rectangle.
- Player Two plays the same way capturing a different group of squares.
- Example game:

- Player one rolls 2 and 4 and encloses 4 rows of 2
- Player two rolls a 3 and 6 and encloses 3 rows of 6



- The winner is the last player to complete a turn before the graph paper is full.
