FOURTH GRADE CHARACTER FOCUS

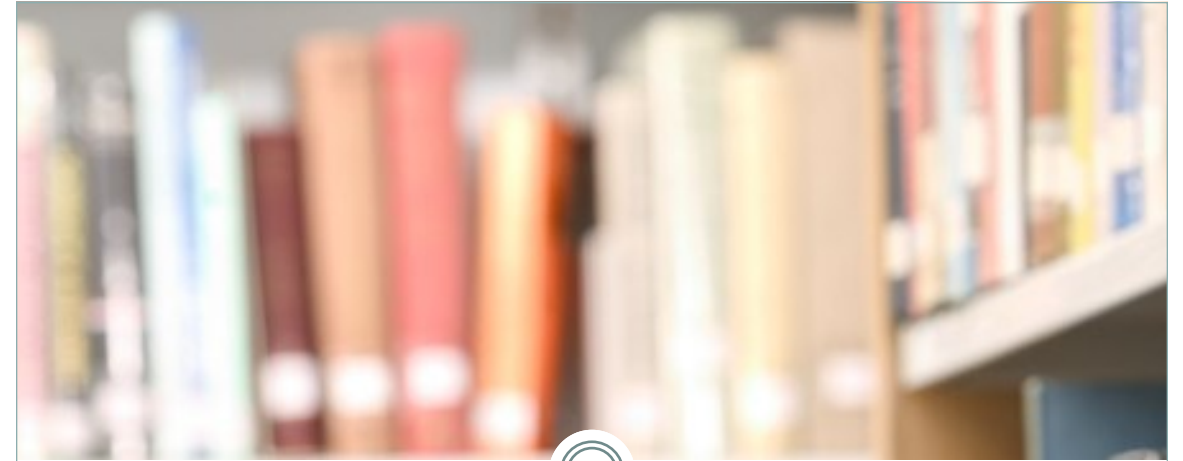
FOR JANUARY HUMILITY : is not regarding yourself as more important than another person.

Fourth grade level academic expectations for absences are as follows:

Please continue to study your spelling words, recitation, and math facts. (Spelling lists are provided on the TCA website and in homework binders).
