School Fee	Technology Fee	\$50 per school year	To cover the cost of computer, printer supplies, and software licensing. <sup>1</sup>
Grades 7-8 School Fee	Naviance College & Career Readiness	\$5	To cover the cost of software licensing, which includes CDE iCAP Readiness. <sup>1</sup>
Grades 9-12 School Fee	Naviance College & Career Readiness	\$5	To cover the cost of software licensing, which includes CDE iCAP Readiness, course planning, and free transcripts up until 2 years after graduation. <sup>1</sup>
Course Fee	English 7	\$20-22*	To cover a portion of the cost of consumable materials used in the course. Students retain books at the end of the course. <sup>1</sup>
Course Fee	English 8	\$26-30*	To cover a portion of the cost of consumable materials used in the course. Students retain books at the end of the course. <sup>1</sup>

Course Fee	HS Science Fee <sup>8</sup> (excluding Physics)	\$15	To cover the cost of consumable materials and/or maintenance of special equipment used in the course. <sup>1</sup>
Course Fee	Biology Fee <sup>8</sup>	\$9	To cover the cost of consumable materials related to the blood typing activity. <sup>1</sup> Does not include HS Science Fee.
Course Fee	Theatre Fee	\$25	To cover the cost of consumable materials and/or maintenance of special equipment used in the course. <sup>1</sup>

Course Fee	Art Fee	\$15	To cover a portion of the cost of consumable materials and/or maintenance of special equipment used in the course. <sup>1</sup>
Course Fee	On Course Fee	\$2	To cover a portion of the cost of the materials used in the course. <sup>1</sup>
Course Fee	Math XL Fee	\$18	To cover a portion of the cost of online software licensing. <sup>1</sup> Fee applies to Pre-Algebra, Algebra I, Geometry, Algebra 2, and Pre-Calculus.
Course Fee	Health & Wellness Fee	\$7	To cover a portion of the cost of CPR & First Aid certification and consumable materials used in the course. <sup>1</sup>
Course Fee	PE Outdoor Adventure Ed	\$70-80*	To cover a portion of the cost of the activities in the course. <sup>1</sup>
Course Fee	Personal Finance Fee	\$35	To cover the cost of the book used in the course. Student keeps the book after the course is completed. <sup>1</sup>
Course Fee	School Supplies	Varies by grade level - see TCA website or class syllabus	Parent purchases various consumable goods for use in the classroom. <sup>2</sup> Major items, like scientific calculators or PE clothes, are retained by the student upon completion of the course.
Course Fee	Concurrent Enrollment Course including ASCENT	Varies - see Concurrent Enrollment Manual and PPSC website	Parents purchase supplies for concurrent enrollment classes and pay some Pikes Peak State College (PPSC) fees directly to PPSC.
Course Fee	Late Fee - PPSC Textbook Return	\$25	Late fee to assist with the cost of providing PPSC textbooks for concurrent enrollment courses.
School Fee	New Student Fee	\$5	To cover a portion of the actual cost of new student orientation. <sup>2</sup>
