TCA's Board of Directors would like to share some highlights from the April 9, 2018 Board Meeting:

Celebrate TCA

We celebrated the recent winners of the D20/Air Academy Federal Credit Union Art Show and the Scholastic Art Awards of Colorado. TCA won a total of 12 first place awards, 3 best of show awards, 4 Gold Keys, a Silver Key and an honorable mention in the competitions with over 5000 entries. It was wonderful to see the artwork our students produced. What a testament to our incredible visual arts program here at TCA!

Construction Update

The North Gym and Auditorium construction continues to be on schedule and under budget. The next month's focus will be on roofing, exterior masonry and interior paint. It is great to see all the progress and the new landscape of the North Campus. Again, we thank you for your flexibility and patience with our construction.

Library Construction

At administration's request, the Board approved appropriating \$740K from community donations (funds previously known as the TCA Endowment) to be used for the buildout of the North Campus first floor library, North Elementary office remodel, and construction of a North Elementary security kiosk. This project was approved by the Board last month, but will now be made possible using gifted funds. Our thanks to the TCA community for prioritizing sacrificial giving for our most important school needs.

Staff Climate Survey

The results of the 2017-2018 Staff Climate Survey were shared by Marta Schulz, Director of Human Resources. The results of survey are once again very positive, and continue to be a consistent indicator that TCA is committed to providing an excellent workplace climate for our staff. We had the highest completion rate ever of 91% from our staff in response to this survey.
