Celebrate TCA

We celebrated the first place winners at the Colorado State Science Fair. TCA sent 26 students to participate in the State Fair, and we placed in 9 categories and received 21 recognition awards. Four of the students shared their winning projects with the Board. Congratulations to all of these students for being invited and competing so well at State. Well done!

Parent Survey

Wes Jolly, TCA's Director of Academic Services, provided a briefing on the annual Parent Survey results. This year, we experienced the sixth best participation rate ever with 1,408 parents contributing to the survey. Overall, parents continue to be engaged year-to-year in participating in the survey, and the data received is important for principals to determine their school's strengths and areas for growth. Staff and teachers continue to be what parents say is the best thing about TCA followed by community/family, character and education/academics. As always, there are also areas for focus and improvement, and school principals have already, or will soon be providing feedback to their individual communities.
