The TCA Board of Directors would like to share the following highlights from our December 12th board meeting:

## Celebrate TCA

Wes Jolly, Director of Academic Services, presented our annual Parent Survey plan, which will take place during the month of February. This year, there will be eight common questions, including one gauging parental support on possible elimination of student access to personal electronic devices during the school day. In addition, the survey will contain several school-specific questions of interest from our individual principals. The added question about electronic devices will provide additional feedback to the Digital Health Committee (DHC) informing their recommendation to the Board by the end of the school year. The DHC also recently emailed parents asking for their participation in School Focus Groups in January/February. Many parents expressed interest and the DHC will be assembling these focus groups shortly after break. The Board looks forward to hearing and receiving both sets of results.
