

3rd GRADE COTTAGE SCHOOL SUPPLY LIST

Welcome to Grade 3 Cottage School!

The following must fit in your child's pencil box or a pencil bag (Please send these on the first day):

- 2 dry erase markers (thin)
- 1 plastic pencil box or pencil bag (do not choose a big one)
- 1 white rubber eraser
- 1 Crayola 24-count box of sharpened, wooden colored pencils (please take these out of the box and put them in the pencil box)
- 1 small pair metal scissors (Fiskars)
- 1 small glue stick

These should be labeled with your child's name (Please send these on the first day):

- 1 plastic blue folder, **with pockets**, no brads, labeled on front with student name and "Take Home" title
- 1 green plastic folder **with 3 prongs and pockets**
- 1 **NEW (students will need all the pages)** composition notebook, wide-ruled (**NOT** a spiral notebook)
- 1 durable 3-ring binder with pockets; 1 inch
 - 5 tabbed dividers with pockets for the binder (Before the first day, **please label "IEW (writing), Vocabulary, Grammar, Literature, and Roots-up"**)
- Backpack with a pocket for a water bottle (large enough to hold all supplies and your child's name on it)
- Water bottle with a secure lid (no glass please)

Community Supplies (to be brought at Meet and Greet):

Boys

- 1 packet of wide-ruled loose leaf notebook paper
- 1 box of Kleenex or paper towels

Girls

- 1 box of wet wipes (unscented – diaper wipes, NOT Clorox type wipes)
- 1 box of quart size or gallon size baggies (not the kind with a slider to close)

MUSIC Supplies:

- No fees or supplies required

PE Supplies

- Wear sneakers to PE class

ART Supplies (these can be brought at Meet and Greet)

All

- 1 large, old T-shirt with student's name written with Sharpie on the front and back
- 1 package unscented baby wipes

Girls

- 2 king size black permanent sharpies

Boys

- 1 roll of paper towels

LUNCHROOM: 1 BOX of UNSCENTED wet wipes – 100 count (diaper wipes, NO Clorox type wipes)
