

8th Grade Supply List 2024-2025

Shared Supplies to be taken to room 3321 on the first day of school:

- 3 boxes of Kleenex
- 1 roll of paper towels
- 1- 3 large container of disinfectant wipes
- 4 thick point dry erase markers for the white board

General Supplies:

- 1 lock for hall locker
- 1 USB flash drive (optional-but very handy)
- 2 packages of loose-leaf college ruled paper (for various classes; may need to be restocked through year)
- Public library card—with knowledge of PIN # (this information may be written inside student planners)
- Backpacks must fit underneath desks and inside locker! (It will be the teacher's discretion as to whether or not backpacks are allowed in the classroom.)
- 1 zippered pencil bag (**stocked with the following items**):
 - 2+ red ink pens ○ 5+ blue or black ink pens ○ #2 pencils—mechanical or wooden (buy enough to last all year) ○ Highlighters (1 of each color: pink, orange, yellow, green, blue) ○ 1 dark colored dry erase marker.
 - Colored pencils: minimum of 16 colors (used in History & Science)

Supplies for Art:

- Spiral bound sketchbook (can use 7th grade sketchbook if there are at least 25 pages)
- 1 white eraser
- 4 small plastic containers with lids (recycled or from dollar store; a recycled yogurt container would also work—think small!). **They will be used to store paint so they must be airtight!**
- 1 paint shirt/smock (used/recycled)
- 1 pack of no. 2 pencils
- 2 paint brushes (one about 1" wide and one detail brush about 1/8 inch wide)
- Ziplock bag full of metal parts and gadgets for recycling sculpture unit. Example: Screws, nuts, bolts, bike chain parts, spark plugs, juice lids, computer parts, springs, etc.
- 1 set colored pencils (any size)

8th Grade

Ancient Civilizations: (one semester)

- 1 College Ruled single subject spiral notebook (100 sheets or more). Height and width must accommodate an 8 ½" x 11" sheet of paper. It would be helpful if the spiral had pockets.
- 3 Elmer's jumbo glue sticks or 6 Elmer's small glue sticks
- Colored pencils- primary colors to include blue, green, brown, yellow, red, tan, black, purple, and orange.
- Highlighter- any color

Civics and Geography: (one semester)

- 3 ring binder
- 2 or 3 subject spiral notebooks of 70 pages or more
- 3 Tabbed dividers

Supplies for PE:

- Combination lock
- Deodorant
- TCA Secondary PE Uniform Requirement:
TCA (PE, Sport, or Activity)t-shirt (crew neck with sleeves)
Shorts or sweatpants-School color (blue, red, gray/silver, or black); if cold, TCA hoodie or sweatshirt (school shorts need to be the longer kind...no shorter than 6 inches above the middle of the knee) Non-marking athletic shoes with tied laces; athletic socks

TCA wear can be purchased through TCA online store (www.tcatitans.org) or a sports/activities coach or club sponsor.

Supplies for Science:

- 1 3-ring 1 ½ inch binder. Label with "Science" and student name on outside of binder.
- 8 tabbed dividers
- Pencil bag containing a small calculator (can be the \$1 kind), 4 dry erase markers, old sock or cloth for an eraser, red pen, highlighter, pencils.

Supplies for English:

- Pikes Peak Library District membership card with pin number
- Students are required to bring a silent reading book of their choice to class on a *daily* basis.
- 1 2 - inch 3-ring binder
- 8 tabbed dividers
- 2 1-gallon zip top bags

*** Research Supplies: (please place these items in a separate zip top bag labeled with the student's name, class period, and teacher's name)**

- 100 3x5 lined index cards (optional: 20 index cards of 5 different colors can be purchased to assist organizing the 5 different sources for the research paper; these cards are specifically for English class, **separate from the cards required for Latin class**)*
- \$1 in loose change for library copies*

***Note:** Students should bring these supplies to class on the first day of school. The teacher will collect the items with an * to keep in the classroom until they are needed for research or general class use.

8th Grade

Supplies for Classical Foundations:

- 1 college ruled spiral.
- 1 inch, 3-ring binder
- 5 highlighters (pink, yellow, orange, blue green; these can be used for multiple classes)
- 200 3x5 lined note cards.
- Pencils for everyday use
- Textbook cover, either plastic or paper (please no stretchy ones!)
- 3 colored pens for grading/correcting homework every week (any color but black)

Supplies for Math:

- 1 3-ring binder (1 or 1.5 inch—any color/design)
- 6-8 tabbed dividers
- 1 package of Graph Paper
- Ruler

Pre-Algebra & Algebra IA only:

- A Scientific Calculator (TI 30 X-A; TI 30 XIIB; TI 3411; or TI 36 recommended) **or** a graphing calculator (TI 83 or TI 84 Plus recommended)

Algebra 1 only:

- A graphing calculator (TI 83 or TI 84 Plus recommended)

Geometry only:

- A graphing calculator (TI 83 or TI 84 Plus recommended)
- Geometry tools (compass, straight edge, protractor)

Supplies for Choir:

- 6 mechanical pencils (to be kept in choir room)
- 3 Dry Erase Markers (to be kept in the choir room)

Computers:

- 1 ream of printer paper

Supplies for Band:

- 10 pencils - one always kept in the music folder for class.
- At least 4 NEW reeds for woodwinds - numbers 2.5 or 3 in strength - see director for clarification.
- Valve oil and slide grease for brasses - please keep in case and label with student's name **Percussion students need:**

Stick bag, Snare Sticks (Vic Firth SD1 General) Bell/Xylophone mallets – clear plastic ball with wooden handle (Vic Firth M6 American Custom -OR-Musser M423 Lexan Bell) Marimba/vibe mallets – medium weight yarn (Vic Firth M3 American Custom), Tympani mallets (Vic Firth T1 Tymp general staccato) and a Drum pad.
